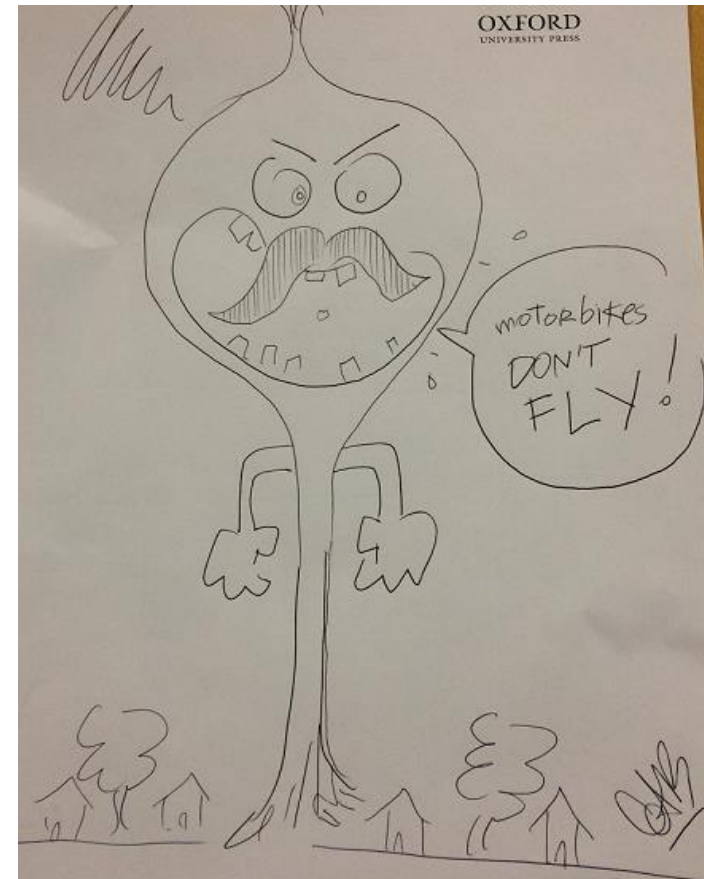
Follow-up questions

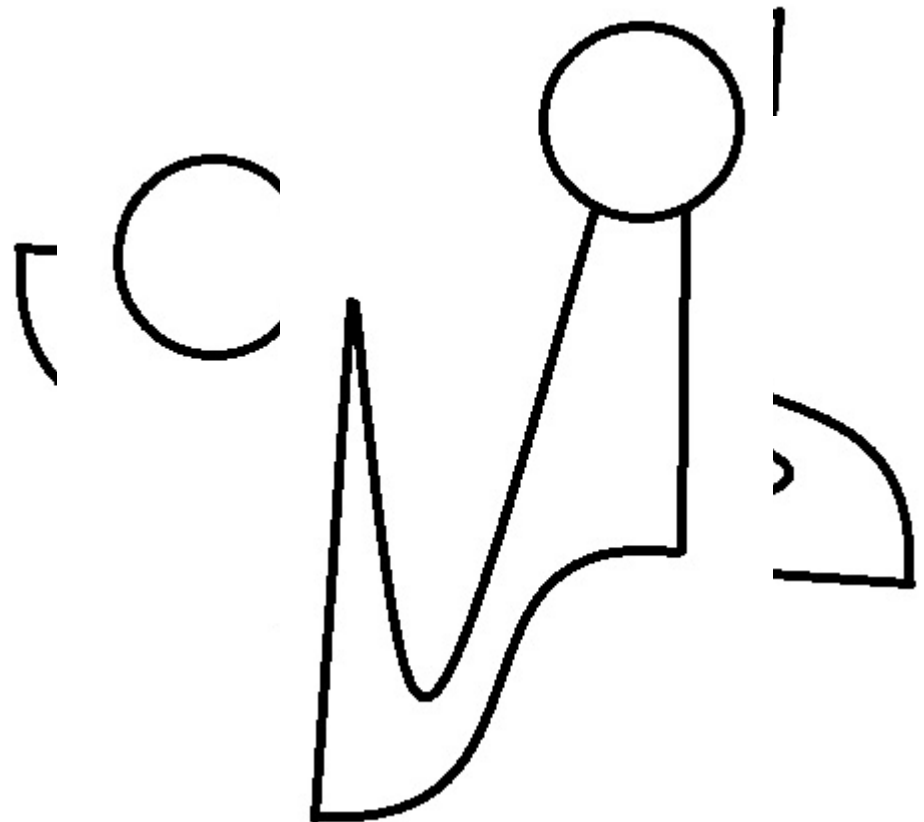

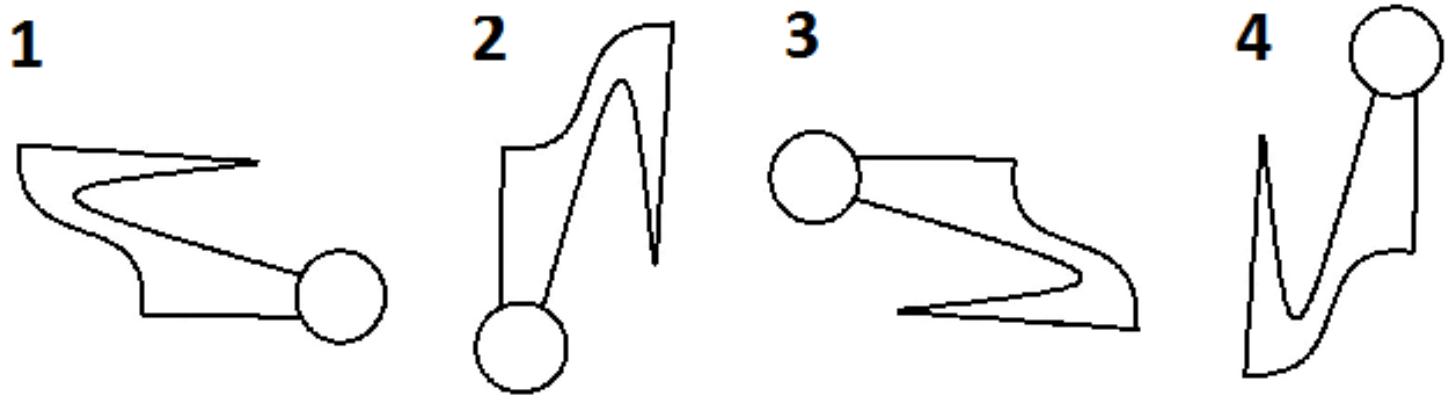


Inventive descriptions

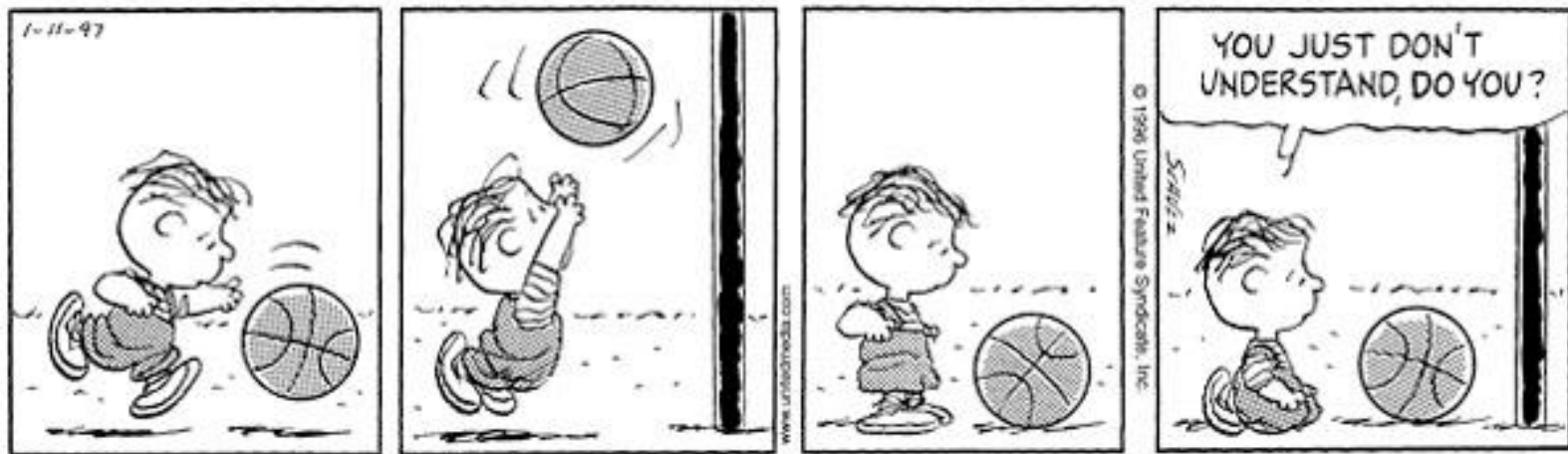
