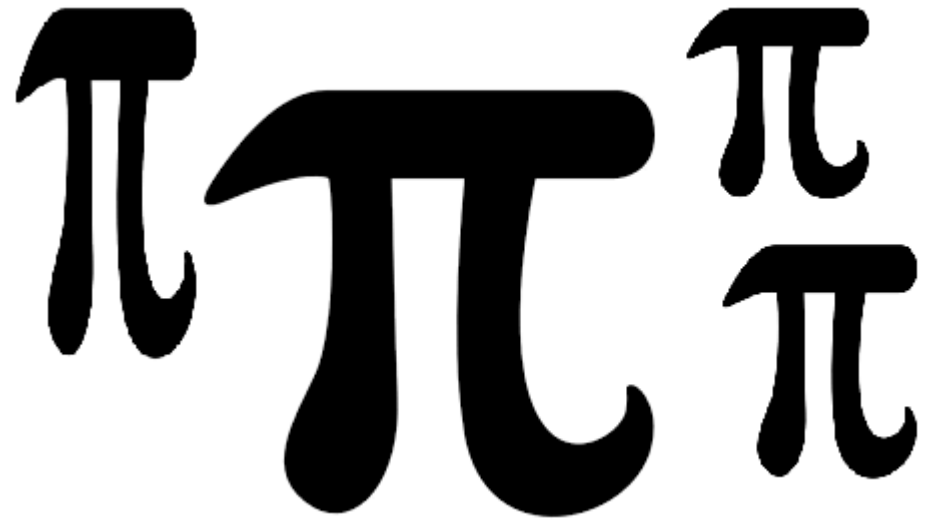

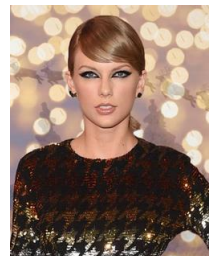

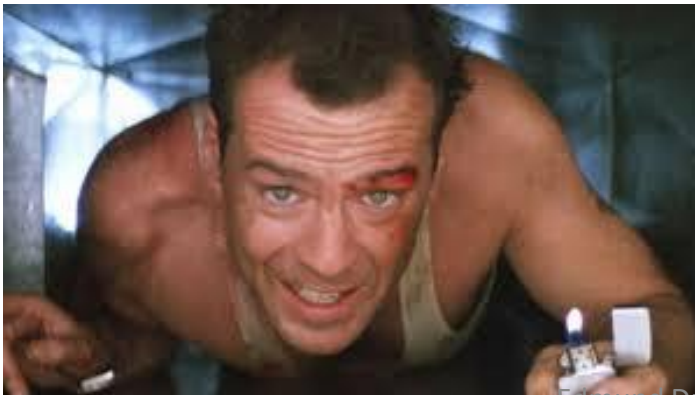

Extreme Gap activity

Procedure

- Find a text on a Christmas theme
- Replace consecutive words with numbered gaps
- Give students a worksheet
- They have to guess the words in the text
- Tell them where the guessed word appears
- Go round. Take turns. Award points
- Prepare a teacher's master version and a teacher's key to help you - I'll show you this afterwards
